## Mones says...

"A spring of living water will well up inside" were Jesus' words to the Samaritan woman. What a promise, what an invitation, she knew what was on offer and responded by saying to Him "Lord give this water so that I do not have come to here again".

Lack of water is not such a problem for us here in Wales, but if you lived in Samaria at the time it would have been, just as it is a major problem in many parts of the world today, for instance women and children often have to walk 3 to 7 miles each way daily to collect enough water for the family. What a trek, what a burden, but it is what you need to remain alive!

Jesus says He is the bread of life, so without Him we will starve, but He also says that He will give us the essential water to drink. Now we all know that we can survive longer without food than we can without water, yet without both bread and water, sooner or later we will die.

However, as He is the giver of food 'bread' we need to have Him in our lives so that we can have the water too. For He is the bread, it's by having Him that we live to begin with, but then beyond becoming alive, in order to remain alive we need the water, and the water that He gives is none other than the Holy Spirit. Just as we cannot live without Jesus, we cannot remain alive without His Holy Spirit. Remember what St Paul said: He is the same power that raised Jesus from the dead, and He lives in me.
